From Mr. Oswald:

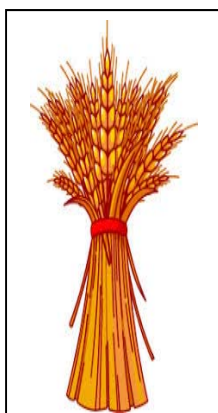
